Connecticut Senator Joseph Lieberman has the support of 21% of the state's registered Democrats, followed by 10% each for Massachusetts' Senator John Kerry and the Reverend Al Sharpton.

Nature of the Sample: 686 New York State Registered Voters

This survey was conducted on April 2^{nd} and 3^{rd} , 2003. 686 registered voters were interviewed by telephone in proportion to the voter registration in each county in New York State and adjusted for turnout in statewide elections. There are 319 registered Democrats. Results are statistically significant at $\pm 4\%$ for registered voters and $\pm 5.5\%$ for Democrats. The error margin increases for cross-tabulations.
