

Nature of the Sample: 634 Americans

This survey was conducted on February 15th, 2006. 634 adults 18 years of age or older within the continental United States were interviewed by telephone. Telephone numbers were selected based upon a list of telephone exchanges from throughout the nation. The exchanges were selected to ensure that each region was represented in proportion to its population. The results of the entire survey are statistically significant at $\pm 4\%$. The margin for error increases for cross-tabulations.
