## Nature of the Sample: 956 U.S. Residents

This survey of 956 United States residents was conducted on March $25^{\text {th }}$, March $26^{\text {th }}$, and March $29^{\text {th }}$. Residents 18 years of age and older were interviewed by telephone. Telephone numbers were selected based upon a list of telephone exchanges from throughout the nation. The exchanges were selected to ensure that each region was represented in proportion to its population. To increase coverage, this land-line sample was supplemented by respondents reached through random dialing of cell phone numbers. The two samples were then combined. Results are statistically significant at $\pm 3.5 \%$. There are 860 registered voters. The results for this subset are statistically significant at $\pm 3.5 \%$. The error margin increases for crosstabulations.
